Forget the degree requirements. In this field, if you can show you can do the work through a portfolio, you can get hired.

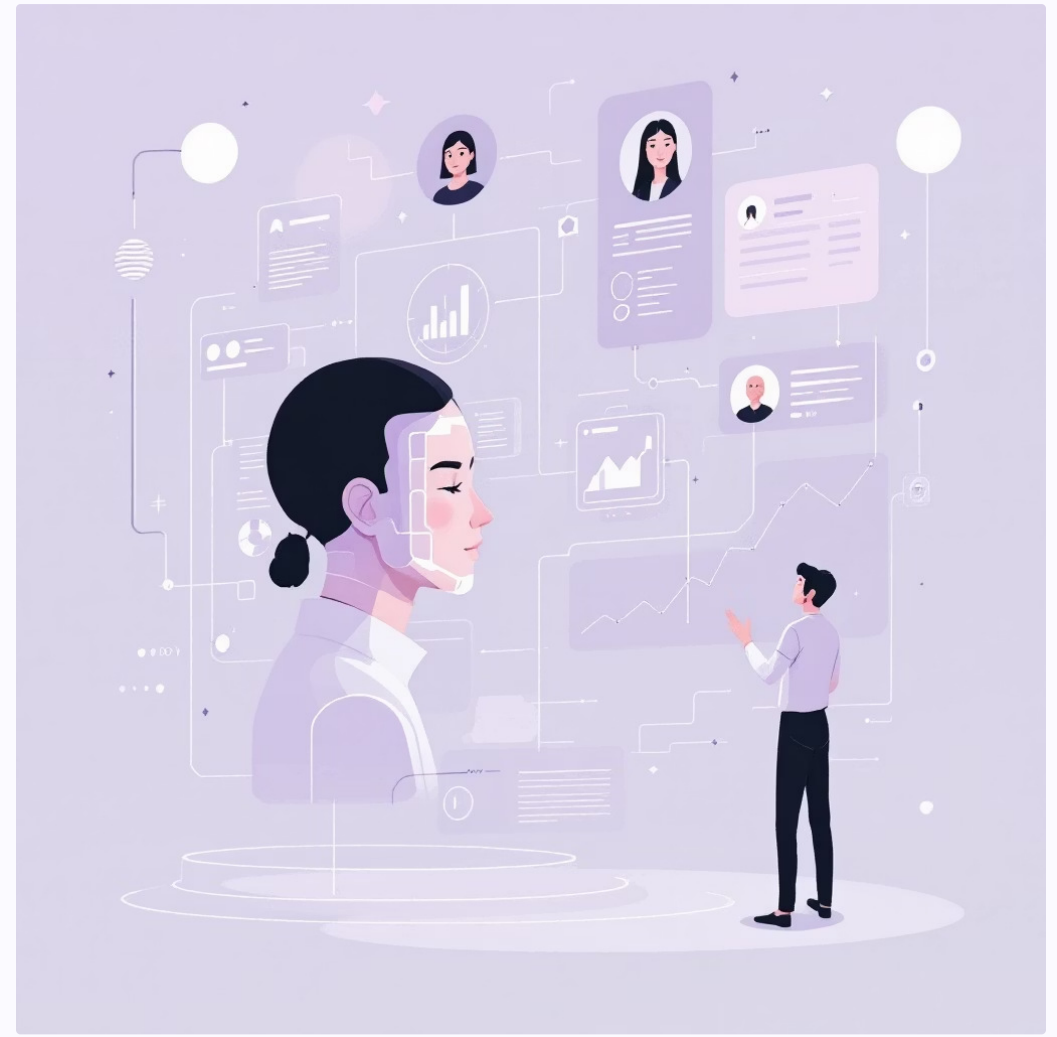
Skill Path 1: Social Media & Visual Content

Create high-quality mockups for Etsy or Shopify listings, helping sellers visualize their products realistically.

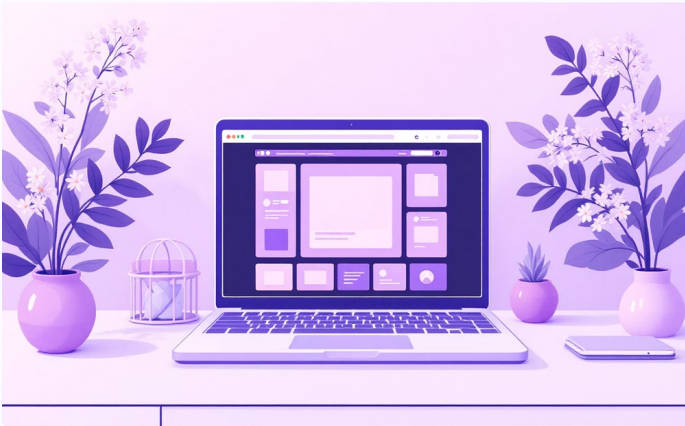


Branding Kits

Build essential starter packs for small businesses: logo variations, color palettes, and font pairings.

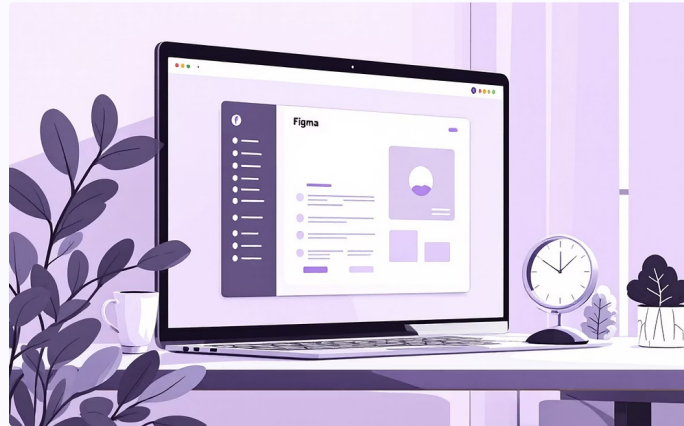
Essential Tools to Get Started

You don't need a massive budget. Start with these accessible tools to build your foundation.



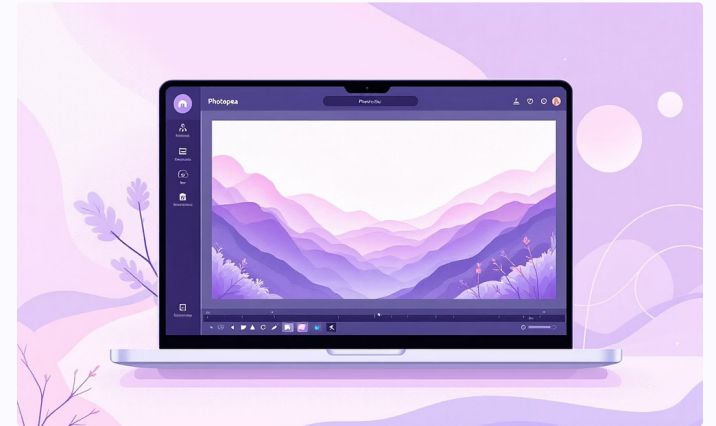
Canva

Take something you already use—a flyer, a resume, or a menu—and redesign it to look better.

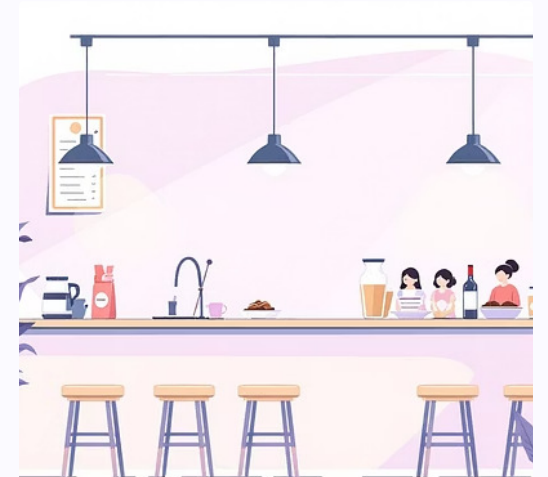
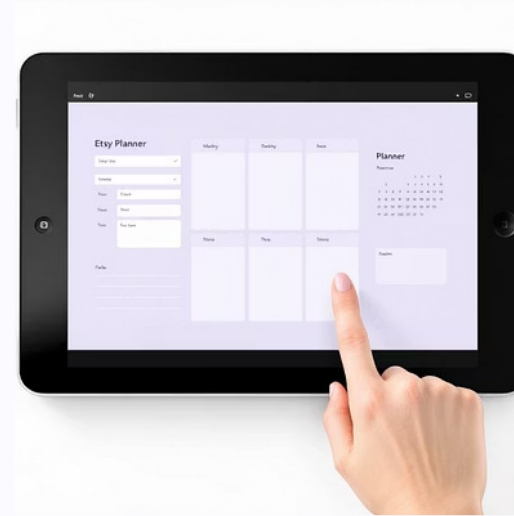


Build a Micro-Portfolio
